About the Spectrum Project...

The **Spectrum Project** is a Saturday program that combines music, movement and drama for children with different abilities. Performers come from the Cedar Valley and range in age from 6 to 17. The project meets each Saturday beginning in January. This performance is a selection of various activities experienced during this year's sessions. The activities use ideas and creations from the performers, along with direction from the UNI students.

Buddies are UNI students and graduates who volunteer each week to work with the performers. Each performer is paired with a Spectrum Buddy for the duration of the project.

Spectrum Theatre was founded by UNI Theatre Professor Gretta Berghammer in 2012. The Spectrum Project, a continuation of efforts to provide performing arts experience for children, is modeled after the Ball State Prism Project, founded by Ryan and Amy Hourigan at Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana.

The Spectrum Project was made possible through a Capacity Building Grant from the University of Northern Iowa.




