


In the beginning, the African forest had many sounds.




The owl hooted.



The lion roared.




The parrot screeched.




and the monkey chittered.



But the frogs were silent.




Monkey said, "I feel like dancing!" So the Elephants kept Rumbling through the Jungle.

It was MUSIC, and it made the Parrots want to dance.




But the frogs were silent.


SCENE 2



Crocodile heard music. Crocodile watched.




Crocodile danced. It was MUSIC!




The crocodiles heard the music the elephants were making and wanted to make their own music.




It started to get windy.




The animals felt small drops of rain falling on them.


The raindrops got bigger and bigger, turning into a large thunderstorm.

SCENE 4


Rhino heard music.

One rhino said, "That sounds fun!" Another rhino said, "We have music too!"


It was MUSIC!

The baboons heard the music the forest animals were making and they started to Move It, Move It.




But the frogs were silent.

"We can just listen," said a third frog.




After so much music and dancing, it was time for bed.
