About the UNI Spectrum Project...

The Spectrum Project is a Saturday program that combines music, movement, drama and art for children with differing abilities. Activities use the performer's ideas with direction from UNI students.

The Spectrum Project performers come from the Cedar Valley and as far away as North Liberty. They range in age from 5 to 19 and meet each Saturday beginning in January.

The Spectrum Project Buddies are UNI, Allen College and Hawkeye Community College students who volunteer each weekend to work with our performers. Each performer is paired with a Spectrum Project Buddy for the duration of the project.

The Spectrum Project is a continuation of efforts to provide performing arts experience for children with differing abilities in the Cedar Valley. This effort began with Spectrum Theatre, founded by UNI Theatre Professor Gretta Berghammer in 2012. The Spectrum Project is modeled after the Ball State *Prism Project*, founded by Ryan and Amy Hourigan in 2010 at Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana.

The Spectrum Project is supported through the UNI School of Music, the Max & Helen Guernsey Charitable Foundation and community supporters.





In its first year (2015), the project enrolled 18 performers and 20 volunteer college buddies. By the second year, the size of the program doubled with 34 performers and 44 volunteer college buddies. The 2017 Spectrum Project has 50 performers, 66 volunteers and a 16 member staff serving 42 families from the Cedar Valley and as far away as North Liberty. They get to have fun, be successful and enjoy working with other people on something creative.

"Before Spectrum Project, Joshua did not have opportunities to engage with other kids because of his communication deficits. Spectrum Project allowed Josh to find his voice and embrace his uniqueness building his self-efficacy in making friends. Through Spectrum Project, Joshua has the confidence to initiate conversations and now participates in extracurricular activities. Yesterday, he was invited for the first time to a birthday party." - Margo Kreger, Parent of Spectrum Project performer

The program employs eight student directors, 5 support personnel, one special education specialist and one administrative assistant. Student directors use the performers' idea, interests and enthusiasms to design the show. Special education specialists provide support to buddies and directors when working with performers with special needs.

"Volunteering for the Spectrum Project was one of the greatest decisions I have ever made and one of the best experiences of my college career. The child I got the opportunity to work with has made the greatest impact on me that I could ever imagine. There is nothing better than getting the chance to spend my Saturdays with a child that has an unending positivity, happiness, and optimism. I came in to Spectrum thinking I would teach my Spectrum buddy, but he ended up teaching me more than I could imagine." - Maureen Hart, Elementary Education, 2017 Asst. Movement Director

The 2017 operating budget of the Spectrum Project is \$18,600. This includes: (1) employment of student directors, special educators, support specialists and administrative assistant, (2) supplies, (3) adaptive devices and instrument, (4) t-shirts, (4) promotional costs and (5) building rental.

The initial funding for this project is running out and with the growth we've experienced, additional support is needed. On this front, we have some exciting news to report. The Spectrum Project recently was awarded a \$7,500 grant for its 2017 spring session from the Max & Helen Guernsey Charitable Foundation. On the heels of that gift, Mike and Lisa Hovanec, have generously pledged \$7,500/yr for 4 years with the hope that others involved with the program will collectively match that total. With these two gifts, we have an opportunity to put this program on solid financial footing for the next several years, but we need your support.
